

Master 2 "Heritage and project-led creation", Specialties: Architecture, Arts, Landscape

The Master 2 "Heritage and project-led creation" (Mention Humanities and creative industries) is a one-year course (with no associated Master 1). By associating practitioners from specific fields (architects, artists or landscapers, but also specialists in literary creation, heritage professions and conservation-restoration), this Master 2 aims to be an interface between the academic world and the professional world.

Presentation

The EUR Humanities, Creation, Heritage (EUR PSGS HCH - Investissement d'avenir ANR - 17 - EURE - 0021) is a research and training consortium on heritage and creation, associating CY Cergy Paris University with 4 great schools and institute, with the participation of the Fondation des Sciences du Patrimoine (Heritage Sciences Foundation), the CNRS and the Ministry of Culture. After initiating and consolidating its doctoral program, the EUR PSGS HCH will open at the start of the 2021 academic year inter-institutional, multidisciplinary and highly internationalized Master 2 in "project-based research".

Program

The Master 2 course "Heritage and project-led creation" offers three specialties this year: Architecture, Arts and Landscape.

Organized in two blocks, it consists of:

- transdisciplinary classes on the principles of project-based research, on heritage and creation, and a workshop practice in the chosen specialty.
- classes in the other specialties offered by EUR PSGS HCH, provided in the schools and institute partners of the program.

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Objectives

The first objective of this master's degree is to implement project-based research, allowing practitioners to return to research without putting their practice aside. The Master thesis will thus combine written report and project, blending the professional, academic and scientific practices of the students.

The other objectives are:

- to obtain a "project-based" master's degree in the fields of architecture, arts and landscape;
- to be familiar with research or to resume scientific research for candidates who would be returning to studies;
- to become familiar with the requirements of research, contribute to research projects in their professional life;
- to have a preparatory year to consider pursuing a doctoral course;
- to benefit from the methodological contribution of the project-led research.

Please note: this Master 2 is not a prerequisite to apply for the EUR PSGS HCH doctoral program nor does it quarantee acceptance of the application for it.

Admission

Prerequisites:

- Master 1 or equivalent
- State diploma for regulated professions.

Application procedures:

- Submit an application file consisting of a project, a cover letter and a resume.
- Study of files by the executive board of EUR PSGS HCH.
- Interview with the candidates selected for hearing before the jury composed of the scientific director of training and the executive board of FUR PSGS HCH.
