Nomination and application

Application process	Step 1: Nomination by the home institution by email. Step 2: Students send within the application deadline the following documents: 1. Application form 2. Motivation letter of the applicant presenting a short description of his/her current artistic work, explains why he/she wants to study at ENSAPC 3. Curriculum vitae (CV) 4. Portfolio of artistic work in PDF format Nomination and application contact: marie.doyon@ensapc.fr
Language Requirement	Courses are mainly taught in French / Few courses are in English A level of B2 of French proficiency is preferable
Deadlines for nomination and application	Fall & Winter semester: May 15 Spring & Summer semester: November 8
Selection process	ENSAPC organizes a selection committee – the applicants will receive an e-mail confirming their acceptance to the school 3 weeks after the application deadline

Orientation Day: on the first week of the semester Holidays: February 8 - February 14 2027 Artistic practice studios are open in June, we usually invite the exchange students to stay until June 30th Please note these dates are specific to the 2026–2027 calendar due to the school's move into its new premises
